



Resilient PNT Forum III

7 April 2015, ENC Bordeaux

The European Navigation Conference (ENC 2015) is being held 7-10 April in Bordeaux. The third Forum on Resilient Positioning, Navigation and Timing (PNT) will be held on the afternoon of Tuesday 7 April 2015, immediately preceding the Conference in the same venue.

This follows two very successful events at ENC 2014 in Rotterdam and ION ITM 2015 at Dana Point CA. The reason for holding these events is the increasing reliance on Global Navigation Satellite Systems in all transport sectors and for essential infrastructure throughout Europe and internationally. The need to ensure resilience of systems, particularly for safety of life and commercially sensitive applications is driving interest in methods for improving robustness of systems to interference and the need for integrity monitoring and authentication methods.

The objective of this third Forum is to focus on resilient PNT solutions that support activities across all applications of navigation and timing and to consider steps towards implementation.
