	ION-CH has pursued the agreement with IEEE initiated for ENC 2016 by the NNF.
	Further discussion about the European Journal of Navigation continued in a separate meeting after the EUGIN Council & Assembly.
-	Exchange of booth with ION-GNSS+
	In Portland OR, ION-CH was allocated a space to promote ENC 2017. Here, two delegates of ION-US will occupy a booth.
-	Permanent Secretariat
-	Postal address of EUGIN
-	Reduced rate at ENC for delegates from EUGIN member institutes
	ION-CH has offered a 50% reduction for one delegate per member institute. This reduction was also valid for the Early Bird rate. This issue has not raised any controversy. The US and the Czech institutes were offered the same conditions.
-	Financial Affairs
	Pierre Bouniol presents the financial report. The balance sheet of ENC 2016 closed with a loss of roughly 5'000 EUR, hence there is no benefit share for EUGIN.
